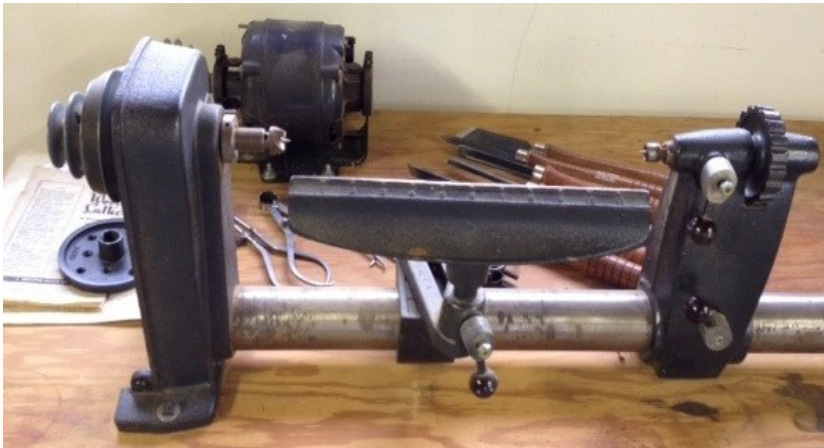

The Cedar Valley Woodworkers Assoc. Board met on October 15, 2013 at Dave Turner's home. It was called to order and started at 7PM. Paul Bailey reported on the Treasurer's Report. Inquiries included; \$15.84 expense of postage. The amount represents a 2 month's supply required for mailing Newsletters for Oct. and Nov. The \$44 postage amount will reflect the postage required to send out letters to the spouse as an invitation to the Christmas Party, held in Dec. Reported too, were Dues paid by 3 members for the coming year -2014. Plus we have one new member that joined at the Oct. Club meet, named Marv. Fangman. It was suggested by Wanda Bailey to Terry D. that he/we encourage members to sign up and pay their dues for the coming year EARLY, so as to avoid the "on-slot" in Dec., taking time away from the Christmas Program.
