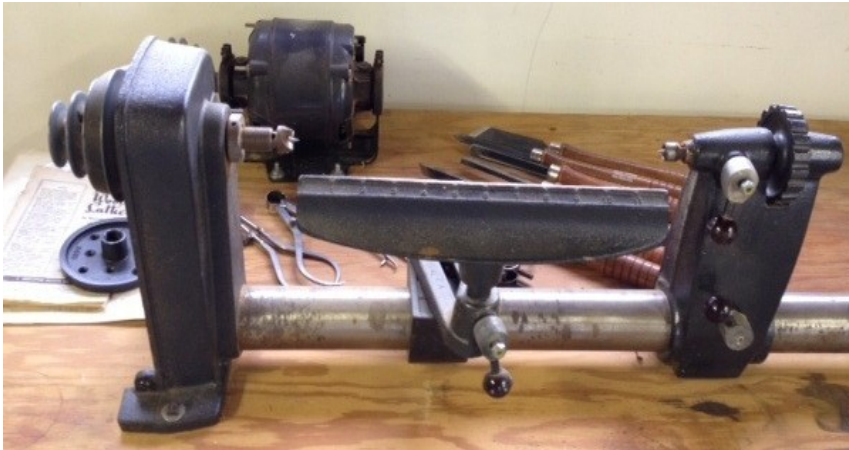

CVWA-Minutes of Board Meet Sept.2013

The Board met at the home of Dave Turner's Sept. 18, 2013, starting promptly at 7PM. Present at the meeting were; Paul and Wanda Bailey, Reed Craft, Terry Duckworth, Dennis Gilroy, Dan Grimes, Bob Hewlett, Gene Knief, Dave Turner, and Jim Wikle. Wanda Bailey motioned and seconded by Dave Turner that Gene Knief would become secretary for the 2013 calendar year, replacing Pat Vollbrecht. There being no discussion, the motion carried unanimously. A big "Thank you!" was mentioned to Dennis Gilroy for a job well done for annual Sept. Fall Picnic and Shop Tour. During the reading of the Treasure's Report, it was brought up regarding the Liability Insurance. Expense and what that entailed (included). It was mentioned that the Club would be protected should an accident occur during a meeting at the Art Center meeting room, or on "tour", etc. Dues for new members, presently at \$25 for the year, and starting in October, would be good for the remaining year of 2013 and all of 2014. Plus, that would also include the opportunity in the drawing for 1 year's free membership. Membership Stands at ninety six. Business cards of the CVWA (Wood Club) were handed out and made available at the Cattle Congress Fall Event, where a total of 35 wood projects

were on display, made by several members of the Club, of which 6-or-7 projects at large. He will feature the use of different types of wood appropriate for specific wood projects. This will include, but not limited to, gun stocks, carving blocks, knife handles and wood turnings, et al. On the November Club meet agenda and program, the Club will need to have the Club's Annual Business Meeting. Barclay Lawler of Amana, IA will present a program as "Model Builder" on wooden trains, steam engines, artist, proto-type and designer. Additionally, the Salvation Army will be present to accept the gifts of toys made by the Club members for the Annual Christmas Toy Giveaway. In lieu of the December Club Meet, the Annual Christmas Party will be held on December 11, 2013 (Wed.) at the Art Center, not on the usual 2nd Tuesday of the month. Also discussed, was the option of changing one of the raffle items at the monthly Club Meet. Wanda Bailey suggested that the 2nd drawing for the "tape measure" be omitted and have only the sanding block, or, changed to another item, as yet undecided. Deadline for entries into the Newsletter is 9/27/13.
